The Alec Haines photos were made during an audio visual project that I was commissioned to do for Grange Court in Leominster that was funded by the Heritage Lottery.

He is well known in the town. Due to his age his memory wasn't what it was. However I asked him to read some passages from a book that he had written about the town and his life, which he took great pleasure in doing.

Mary Bedford is a lady that I met when walking in North Herefordshire as some footpaths run through her small-holding. She always wants to chat and pass the time of day and often comes out of her cottage when I approach it.

Ken Childs is the father of a school friend. He was bemused that I wanted to photograph and record him and was convinced that he had nothing to say of interest.

What they have in common is that they live on their own, and have all been bereaved by the death of a child.

Since doing this work I have found more and more people who want or their friends and family want me to photograph and record.

For me the fascination is that you never really know what they are going to say into the microphone or how they will present in front of the camera.

As much as I'm interested in them I am interested also in their belongings and their homes. I like to capture the context and show how people live.

Alongside this I make and edit audio recordings that are a little like a long conversation about their lives.
